Introduction

Until recently, writings about American radicalism of the 1960s and 1970s have been fragmented and partisan in nature. Participants in the radical movements of that era have begun to publish their memoirs, but the authors' perspectives color these important sources. The participants' advocacy even continues to influence contemporaries who write about American radical movements from an outsider's point of view. Scholarship attempting a fair and accurate portrayal of that turbulent time therefore requires two things: a widening of perspective through the passage of time, and a supply of primary sources that is broad and detailed enough to identify and represent the divergent voices and issues of the period. The passage of more than thirty years has brought about that broadening of perspective. Today, there are young scholars who, fascinated by the stories of their parents and grandparents, have brought new energy to the study of the 1960s and 1970s. Since 1970, Michigan State University (MSU) has presciently been gathering and organizing a collection of materials on the topic of American radicalism, partly in anticipation of such scholarly interest. Over the last three decades, this unique collection has evolved into a significant contribution to the field—one that supports today's new wave of scholarship. To date, there are more than 25,000 items organized into over 2,250 files in the American Radicalism Collection. The collection's files fall into three categories: organizations (e.g., Christic Institute, Southern Africa Liberation Committee), individuals (e.g., David Duke, Jane Fonda), and key topics and events (e.g., Detroit riots, paganism).

Origins and Rationale of the American Radicalism Collection

In 1970, the Special Collections staff at MSU began the American Radicalism Collection. The staff had come to appreciate the value of presenting student researchers with issues and ideas from outside the mainstream. From the beginning, local faculty and student participants in various radical movements donated ephemeral materials—leaflets, small pamphlets, fund-raising letters, and local newspaper clippings. Since then, the files have continued to accumulate material and to broaden the scope of this growing collection of underground, left-wing, and right-wing newspapers, periodicals, and monographs advocating social change.

A relatively straightforward working definition of radicalism has governed the development of the American Radicalism Collection: a document is considered radical if it advocates social change from outside the political or cultural mainstream. From the beginning, MSU has invited and encouraged individuals to contribute documents, as no money was ever set aside to purchase materials for the radicalism files. As a result of this approach, the collection includes anything that a donor might have considered radical, making the files uniquely inclusive. An advocacy group, by definition, is geared toward disseminating information about itself; therefore, the names of most donors and supporters were promptly added to each group's mailing list. The wide distribution of materials has contributed to the growth of the collection. Because activists donated materials, the file cannot be treated as objective archives of their organization or topic. However, there has been no particular attempt to strive for objectivity on such a fraught topic. Rather, the files, as gathered, provide objectivity through the multiplicity of materials, requiring

those reading the files to apply their own perspectives.

Moreover, the collection process has not ended with materials from the late 1960s and 1970s; the collection includes materials from the 1980s the 1990s, and the beginning of the twenty-first century. As a totality, the American Radicalism Collection provides a non-idealized and minimally brokered snapshot of social change concerns in the United States from 1970 to the present. The groups included present themselves through the minutiae of their struggles to organize and through the unvarnished reports of journalism contemporary to the time.

A History of American Radicalism

“Radicalism” is an inclusive and general term that invites subjectivity, implies diversity and contention, and demands clarification at every turn. Not all radicalism can clearly be traced to the Left or the Right, and as many interpretations of this term as possible have been taken into account in the building of the American Radicalism Collection. For example, in deciding whether it is radical to advocate birth control, it is important to know whether we are treating birth control as a feminist issue, as part of the *Playboy* philosophy of the 1960s, or as a plank in the platform of the Catholic pro-choice movement. We may well consider the advocating of birth control to be radical in all of these cases. Therefore, any ephemera reflecting these viewpoints—or opposition to them—were routinely added to the file on birth control.

Under this elastic definition of radicalism, the collection is especially rich in material from the American Left, particularly the anti-war movement. However, there are also many publications from opposing viewpoints, from white supremacist and other far-right organizations, and from religious groups and other sources usually thought of as non-political.

Although the United States had experienced an upsurge of radical activity in the 1930s, the radicalism beginning in the 1960s had a distinct character, one that has influenced progressive and “leftist” struggles around ethnic, gender, peace, environmental, and cultural issues over the past thirty-five years. Throughout the 1950s, the McCarthy era engendered a sense of frustration, as did the setbacks suffered by the civil rights movement of the 1960s. This frustration contributed to a cohort of new movements and groups that soon became household words: Black power, women’s liberation, Students for a Democratic Society, gay liberation, the United Farm Workers Organizing Committee, to name a few. The pro-labor and Marxist bent of many 1930s radicals did not hold sway in this era of the New Left, even though Marxist, Maoist, Stalinist, and Trotskyite organizations tried to infuse revolutionary content into the energetic new groups. Instead, most radicals espoused goals for social change that were, for the most part, intricately tied to experiences outside the workplace. The new movements tended toward the chaotic, preferring coalition building to ideological unification. Even though these new radicals and their movements produced a great deal of literature—manifestos, leaflets, and factional debates—their existence was generally brief. They archived their own materials randomly, if at all. It is these rare and ephemeral materials that the American Radicalism Collection seeks to preserve at Michigan State University and through this microfilm edition.

Student and Anti-War Groups: The New Left

The student free speech and anti-war movements of the late 1960s and early 1970s triggered the creation of the American Radicalism Collection at MSU. The free speech movement began at the university in the form of an organization called the Committee for Student Rights (CSR). This gave way to a group called United Students that was, in turn, folded into a local chapter of Students for a Democratic Society (SDS). This local SDS chapter served as an umbrella organization, with separate committees working on draft resistance, racism, opposition to the war, and local topics. It also published the local underground newspaper during the paper's final years.

While Old-Left Marxist and union-based factions remained active in the late 1960s and early 1970s (and are therefore represented among the files in the American Radicalism Collection), these elements came to appear less radical than the New Left. In this respect, the media, which had brought the war in Vietnam into American living rooms and dormitories, helped the new groups by encouraging Americans to publicly question and oppose the war. This access to the media eliminated the need for the revolutionary rhetoric and seemingly old-fashioned tactics of earlier left-wing groups: hippies and student radicals now regularly appeared on television, even if the media's representation usually made it difficult to understand their actions and their goals.

Feelings ran high between students and their parents, and MSU was one of the battlegrounds of this new generation gap. The university was home to one of the five founding newspapers of the Underground Press Syndicate--*The Paper*--which began in 1965. In 1968, the local chapter of SDS hosted the SDS National Convention, and in 1969, MSU's SDS members comprised a large portion of the founding cadre of the underground group, the Weathermen. The combined attention of mainstream journalism and the underground press provided broad coverage of SDS and its activities, but the paper trail hardly ends there. In 1970, when SDS began to fragment and started leaving MSU one faction at a time, the library acquired the office files of the local organization. The research value of these files was immediately obvious, serving as the centerpiece of the American Radicalism Collection ever since. These files document each step in the evolution of much of the radicalism at the university. They include pamphlets and position papers by SDS on every issue addressed by the New Left, as well as documentation on local meetings, national conferences, demonstrations, and communications with chapters at other universities. The richness of the SDS files, all included in the microfilm edition, is what prompted library staff to begin accumulating primary materials on other radical organizations and issues.

The Radical Right

When the Federal Building in Oklahoma City was bombed on the morning of April 19, 1995, American journalists drew a connection between the term "Michigan Militia" and the event. That afternoon, three national news organizations called the library at MSU to request the contents of

the vertical file on the Michigan Militia in the American Radicalism Collection. It wasn't a large file at the time, but it was the only material on the topic cataloged in OCLC WorldCat. Although right-wing movements have proven more difficult to document than left-wing groups, the library at MSU created dozens of files that represent the activist right. Among them are files on the Michigan Militia and other militia groups, which, because of the secretive nature of these organizations, consist primarily of news clippings. Modern factions of the Ku Klux Klan are well represented through local newspaper clippings, as well as older paper artifacts. Files on right-to-life organizations, such as Operation Rescue, and Christian rightist movements, such as the Moral Majority, include pamphlets, membership materials, and fund-raising letters, as well as clippings. The right-wing collection contains many pamphlets and mailings generated by patriotic and anti-Communist organizations such as the John Birch Society. The collection also includes pamphlets, clippings, and ephemera on such controversial topics as survivalism, Holocaust denial, creationism, and anti-Catholicism.

Minority and Gender Rights

The areas of homophobia, racism, and sexism dominate many of the topical files in the collection. Because the accumulation process began in the early 1970s, the library staff was able to put together significant contemporary files on gay liberation, lesbian separatism, Black liberation and Black nationalism, Native American causes, the United Farm Workers, and second-wave feminism. Local activists involved in these and other causes contributed a flow of contemporary pamphlets and leaflets. Most of these movements were in some way acknowledged by or connected to other movements, an interconnectedness reflected in the collection. For example, subfiles on the Black Panther Party and the women's liberation movement can be found in the SDS collection. Material on gay activism began to be collected just after the Stonewall Riot in New York City in 1969 and is well represented. The collection documents gay-affirmative movements within several churches, including Baptist, Catholic, Episcopalian, Lutheran, Mormon, and Presbyterian. Material on AIDS has been collected for its important connection with gay activism throughout the 1980s and 1990s. Materials on Native American radicalism include important files on the Wounded Knee occupation in South Dakota in 1973 and the American Indian Movement (AIM). Issues of aging are addressed in several files, including one on the Gray Panthers. A number of files on the American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU), mostly dating from 1970 on, thoroughly cover racial and gender civil rights. Other important issues addressed in the collection include assisted suicide, which is represented as a civil rights issue, and affirmative action.

Cultural and Environmental Radicalism

Hippies, communards, alternative educators, and ecological activists represent a less overt but equally important kind of political activism. The collection includes information on alternative schools, communal experiments, and green politics and green parties, such as the Earth First organization. There are files on animal rights and endangered species, genetic engineering, recycling, LSD advocates Ken Kesey and Timothy Leary, Kwanzaa, rainforests, and Koinonia

Partners, the interracial agricultural commune, to name just a few.

Scholars and Students

The pamphlets, leaflets, newspaper clippings, and correspondence we now call ephemera were uniformly vital tools of communication to the organizers who generated them. Today, these valuable, rare, and often fragile primary sources have been preserved in the microfilm edition. The broad reach of the American Radicalism Collection makes it inherently useful to advanced scholars, especially in the fields of American history, American studies, political science, gender studies, and gay and lesbian studies. Though no collection can include everything on such a wide range of topics, the materials in the American Radicalism Collection, because they feature so much ephemera, are less likely to be duplicated in other sources—books, periodicals, and other library collections. For the graduate or professional scholar who is on the track of “everything,” searching the collection’s microfilm edition will be a necessary step. The edition’s organization by subject should make it easy for the researcher to locate information on both particular and related topics, organizations, and individuals.

Published scholarship supported by this collection includes Kenneth Heineman’s *Campus Wars: The Peace Movement at American State Universities in the Vietnam Era* (New York: New York University Press, 1993). At the conclusion of his writing, Heineman donated his own archive of photocopies, interviews, and ephemera to the American Radicalism Collection for future researchers. Author Wyn Craig Wade’s book, *The Fiery Cross: The Ku Klux Klan in America* (New York: Simon and Schuster, 1987), was likewise improved in important ways by a visit to this collection, and his archive has been similarly deposited.

Undergraduate students will certainly use the microfilm edition to good effect. At MSU, many a term paper on the Black Panther Party, draft resistance, or assisted suicide has sprung from material in the collection. Instructors are also inspired by the collection. As a typical assignment, students are asked to compare viewpoints on an issue or organization as found in mainstream contemporary print sources that quote the declarations and reasoning of the advocates or participants. The American Radicalism Collection tends to further motivate students to compare their own times and activism with that of their parents and grandparents by providing access to vivid contemporary accounts of the recent past.

Editorial Note

Documents from *The American Radicalism Collection*, from the holdings of the American Radicalism Collection, Special Collections, Michigan State University Libraries, will be published in four parts. Each part represents a major subject category of the collection:

Part 1, Leftist Politics and Anti-War Movements

Part 2, The Religious and Radical Right

Part 3, Race, Gender, and the Struggle for Justice and Equal Rights

Part 4, Twentieth-Century Social, Economic, and Environmental Movements

Organization and Format

The American Radicalism Collection consists of vertical files on groups, individuals, and a host of topics. The materials represent a wide range of viewpoints, from the far right to the far left, on political, social, cultural, sexual, and economic issues in America. For ease of use by the researcher, the microform edition has been organized into the four parts noted above, which reflect the major subject groupings in the collection. Each folder was assigned to the part in which it fit best.

This guide lists materials in the order in which they appear on the reels. Materials in each part are arranged on the reels according to an alphabetized listing of the topics for that part, as listed on each folder. Occasional cross references will aid the reader to locate related materials. Part 1, Leftist Politics and Anti-War Movements, is divided into three sections because it contains the greatest amount of material; Part 2, The Religious and Radical Right, consists of one section; Part 3, Race, Gender, and the Struggle for Justice and Equal Rights, is divided into two sections; Part 4, Twentieth-Century Social, Economic, and Environmental Movements, consists of one section.

Selection Process

The selection of materials for the microform edition of *The American Radicalism Collection* was based on several criteria:

Relevancy

This microfilm collection comprises selected materials from the original American Radicalism Collection from Michigan State University Libraries. Selections emphasize the relevance of the material to the development of American radical movements in the twentieth century. Materials with little relevance to these topics were excluded from the microfilm edition.

Rarity

Some printed materials, such as commonly held government reports, were excluded because they can be found in many libraries. Materials available without charge to the

public on an organization's website were also excluded.

Research Need

Certain materials were not microfilmed largely because of their relatively low priority with respect to research needs. Examples of such materials include multiple fund-raising solicitations, which had been collected as part of the materials on a particular organization.

Privacy

Some materials could not be microfilmed for reasons of confidentiality. In the interest of protecting the privacy of individuals, a concerted effort was made to exclude records that contained people's home addresses, phone numbers, Social Security numbers, or personal financial information.

Notice of Unfilmed Materials

Folders excluded in their entirety are not listed in this collection guide. These materials are, however, available to researchers who use the collection on site at the Special Collections Library at Michigan State University.
